

**TRENTON MUNICIPAL UTILITIES**  
**WATER RATES**  
**Effective July 1, 2020**

The following user charge rate schedule shall be assessed to all persons, firms, corporation, companies, institutions, and organizations for water furnished and supplied by the City of Trenton, Missouri, or any department thereof.

First 1,000 Cu. Ft. per month	\$ 4.79 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.	\$ 5.73 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.
Next 9,000 Cu. Ft. per month	\$ 4.20 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.	\$ 5.05 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.
Next 190,000 Cu. Ft. per month	\$ 3.38 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.	\$ 4.05 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.
Next 800,000 Cu. Ft. per month	\$ 2.76 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.	\$ 3.33 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.
Over 1,000,000 Cu. Ft. per month	\$ 2.50 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.	\$ 3.00 / 100 Cu. Ft. / Mo.

A separate minimum charge shall be made for each meter serving an individual customer.

**WATER TAP FEES:**

1" or less	\$ 75.00 per tap plus materials
2" or 4"	\$ 150.25 per tap plus materials
6"	\$ 300.40 per tap plus materials

**Rates above do not include the Missouri DNR Drinking Water Primacy. This fee is assessed by DNR annually and charged to customers as a separate line item on the utility bill.**

**Sales tax on water is as follows: Residential – 3%, Residential outside city limits – 1.5%, Commercial – 8.35%, Commercial outside city limits – 5.725%, 100% Manufacturing tax – 4.125%**

**Effective Date of New Rates**

The new water rates established herein shall become effective with usage beginning June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 usage and on bills posted on or after June 30, 2020.

Passed by the City Council on March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Council approved to delay the final increase from April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 usage to June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 usage during the city council meeting on April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020.
